- Successfully advocated to create a Federal investment tax credit for microgrid controllers in the IRA

- Submitted comments to DOE on proposed revisions to building energy performance standards and implementation of multiple incentives for grid resilience and innovation included in the IJJA

- Extensively engaged in PUC proceedings to develop microgrid-specific tariffs in CA and HI
